What is the International Student Poster Presentation Conference (ISPPC)?

The International Student Poster Presentation Conference, organized by the School of English and American Studies (SEAS), is an annual conference for BA, MA, and PhD students.

When is the next ISPPC conference?

The next ISPPC will be held in person between 22 and 25 April 2024 at the School of English and American Studies.

Why is it worth applying for the ISPPC?

The ISPPC is an excellent opportunity for students to present and receive feedback on an interesting home paper, a chapter or initial ideas of their thesis, or some other research project in any phase.

Who can apply?

Students from all over the world can apply for the ISPPC.

How can I apply?

What topic areas are accepted?

Posters are welcome in any of the following topic areas:

- English and American literature
- English and American history
- English speaking cultures
- Theoretical linguistics
- Applied linguistics
- Language pedagogy (including ELT)

What happens after my abstract was accepted?

After your abstract is accepted, you will have one month to submit your poster by email. A committee consisting of experts will review your poster and recommend changes if necessary. Once you have made the requested changes, you must print your poster in A0 format (1189 mm x 841 mm).

Where and when should I bring my printed poster?

Students are required to bring their printed posters to the venue of the ISPPC (the third floor of Building R) on Monday morning.

What happens at the ISPPC conference?

Students' posters will be displayed for a week. On Monday and on Friday, students are encouraged/required to stand next to their posters and answer questions during the breaks.
